Dear Parents and Carers,

The Year 6 pupils this week have been superb with their SATs tests and have shown a fantastic work ethic in their approach to them. A brilliant well done to them as well as parents and families for their support and staff for the preparation and the successful delivery of this week. These tests are sent off to be marked externally and we don't receive the results until July! In the meantime, there is much to focus on in school and along with the normal curriculum to be delivered there are other events to look forward to! I sent out a set of dates both by attachment and paper copy with what is planned so far – keep looking for any additional dates/information – it is certainly gearing up to be a busy time. One event that has been further discussed is Sports Day on 7th July – in the morning, KS2 children will participate in their teams in a variety of events around the field area and in the afternoon KS1 and EYFS will complete the same. Parents are welcome to spectate on this day.

This week, it was the turn of some Year 3 & 4 to visit the library and next week the other children will attend – they all enjoyed returning to the Library and were given a form to sign up should they wish. Please return that directly to the library.

Our value this term is 'Perseverance' and this week we explored refugees and the perseverance they need to rebuild their lives. We also have looked at Mental Health Week and Loneliness. In our Picture News discussion this week the question focused on What Makes us Unique – please see the 'Take Home' sheet if you wish to discuss this at home further.

Year 1 parents had the opportunity to learn more about the Year 1 Phonics Check that takes place after Half term. Thank you to those who attended – if you were unable to attend you will find an informative PowerPoint on the website.

As a staff we further planned our school Jubilee Day this week as well as discussed English at length. We also reviewed the first couple of weeks of the Homework changes. EYFS and KS1 shared some lovely examples of homework from the grids being brought in. As a reminder on a Wednesday a piece of homework from the EYFS/KS1 homework grid can be brought in and shared. There is an expectation that 2 pieces will be completed altogether. In KS2 the Gallery Day for sharing will be on Monday 18th July. As a reminder there is a requirement that children complete Reading, Spelling and Maths work each week – these we feel are core skills that children need regular practice in – if not completed parents/carers will receive an email.
