GOOGLE CLASSROOM: EXAMPLE



Our Google for Education platform will act as a means of communication between your child and teacher throughout any further school closure. It allows teachers to set lessons, answer questions, provide feedback and talk to the class via Google Meet.

To access Google Classroom, **Example** has been set up with a Google for Education account. It consists of a unique username which is based on their name and our school domain. This takes the form of an email address:

USERNAME: **example@christopher-rawlins.co.uk**

PASSWORD: **example01**

Google for Education Accounts

The Google for Education account for **Example** is assigned to **Example** CE Primary School. Google does not track the activities of this account for advertising or marketing reasons, but we have full visibility of your child's actions whilst using Google Classroom. This email address is just a username and Gmail is not available to pupils.

How does my child access their Google for Education account?

Google for Education can be accessed from any computer or tablet that has access to the internet. We have a link via a portal on our website or you can simply go to Google and login with your child's username and password.
