



**Christopher Rawlins CE Primary School are celebrating Word Book Day on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022.**

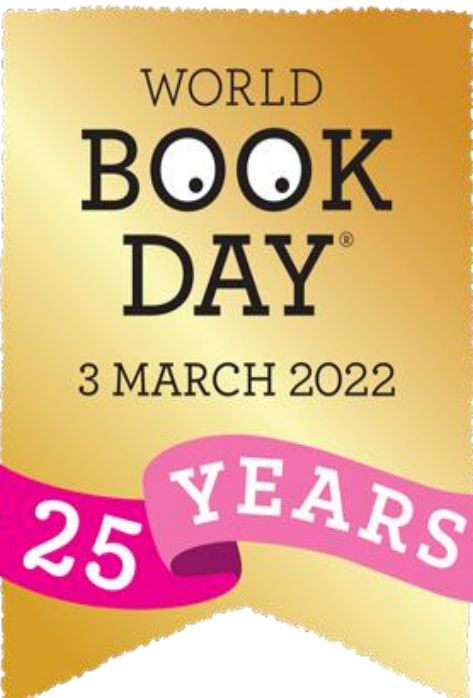
