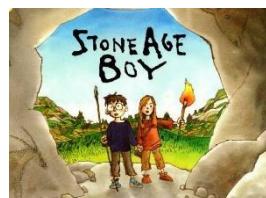


Autumn Term: Stone Age Homework Grid Year 3 and 4



Here are your homework tasks for the Autumn Term. We would like you to bring three completed tasks into school in the last week of Term 1 ready to share on 23rd October. Then three more in the week commencing 15th December, to share that week. Try to do a variety of tasks and present your work in an interesting and creative way. We look forward to seeing all your amazing work.

Write an acrostic poem about the Stone Age. Remember to include historical information and as a challenge try to include some rhyme.	Go for a walk and collect some natural materials that can be used to create a Stone Age themed picture of your choice.	Create a recipe card for a meal using only ingredients found in the Stone Age. If you make something too, please send a photo in so we can see what you made.	Research and select your favourite type of rock and create a factfile. You need to include; an image, how it is formed, three facts about it and how it is used in the world around us.
Over two weeks record how much rubbish is thrown away in your house. You could weigh your rubbish sack once they are filled and calculate the total over two weeks. Is there anything you could do to reduce the amount you throw away? Does your family reduce, reuse and recycle? If so, tell us what you do.	Create a wordsearch using vocabulary we have been using in our Stone Age lessons, or in our Science lessons focusing on rocks and soils.	Make a replica of Stonehenge or any other Stone Age monument. You could use: match boxes, plasticine, real stones, lego... the more inventive your choice of material the better! Make sure your construction is secure enough to be carried into school. Perhaps it could sit on a tray or the lid of a box?	Take a trip to see a stone circle. The Rollright Stones are not too far away, near Chipping Norton. There is Stonehenge of course, if you are on a trip in that direction, or you may spot other sites on a map. If you do go on a trip, we would love to hear all about it. Alternatively, you could do some research and find out about a stone circle, or stone circles in general.
Create your own Stone Age prop. It could be a spear, a piece of jewellery or an item of clothing.	Create a title page for both your Stone Age History topic.	Research a Stone Age animal including facts about its diet, habitat and its extinction status.	You are a Stone Age boy or girl! Share with your fellow villagers what you have been up to by writing a diary entry.
